# REGINA REVITALIZATION INITIATIVE STADIUM CONCOURSE

Regina, Saskatchewan

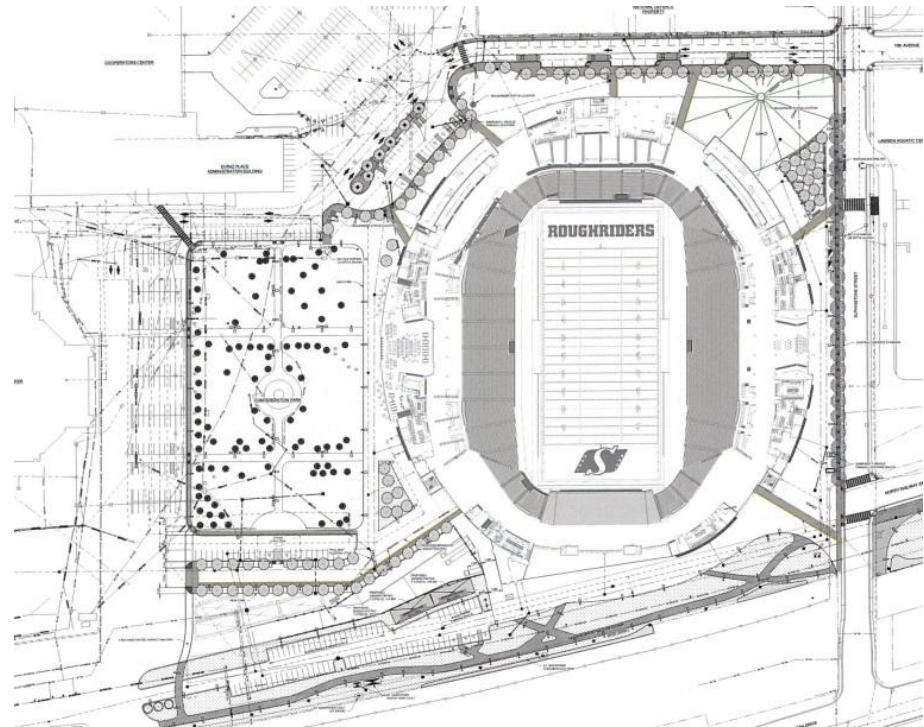
Completion Date: June 2017

Layout of outdoor concourse and plazas including:

- Northeast plaza - “Riderville Fan Plaza”, the focus of identity and activity for Roughriders fans before and after games.
- Northwest accessible drop off, VIP arrival area, and emergency, service vehicle, and executive parking
- Bus mall on the north side, with loading platforms and queue areas separate from pedestrian movement path
- 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue extension concept, including travel lane orientation, parking, and drainage
- Emergency vehicle route and parking
- Southwest entrance plaza and access corridor from Evraz Place parking field
- South multi-use pathway (not built).

The work included:

Pedestrian /crowd flow studies, consideration for safety/security, design for accessibility, and use scenarios for a range of events, seasons, and times of day.



The Stadium is part of the City of Regina’s revitalization program for major redevelopment lands downtown. The Stadium will be the new home of the Saskatchewan Roughriders (CFL) as well as a major venue for sports, entertainment, exhibitions, and conferences. Seating capacity: 40,000 (peak).
